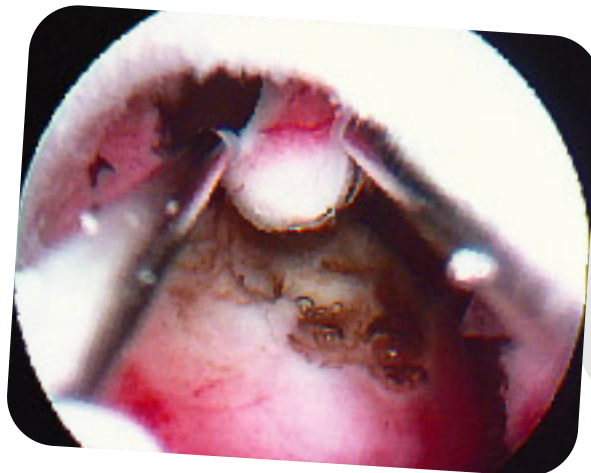
Office & Operative Hysteroscopy
