NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital (NY-P Hospital) is a 2,369-bed academic medical center based in New York City. The Hospital provides state-of-the-art inpatient, ambulatory, and preventive care in all areas of medicine at five major centers: New York Weill Cornell Medical Center (NYWCC) on Manhattan's Upper East Side, Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center (CPMC) in Washington Heights, Morgan Stanley Children's Hospital of NewYork-Presbyterian (CHONY) in Washington Heights and on the Upper East Side, the Allen Pavilion in the Inwood section of Manhattan, and the Westchester Division in White Plains.

With its 2,369 beds, approximately 93,000 discharges and more than 830,000 outpatient visits annually, NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital is the largest hospital in the New York, and one of the most comprehensive and well-recognized healthcare institutions in the world.
